Lou was also a founding member of the Proposition 10, First 5 California State Commission. Presently he is a member of multiple advisory organizations, including the UC Davis School of Education.

In 2000 Dr. Vismara changed careers, retiring from his medical career to work as a full-time senior policy consultant for the California State Senate. Lou has worked on numerous health-related initiatives and was instrumental in the formation of the California Legislative Blue Ribbon Commission on Autism. Currently, Lou is a senior member of Sen. Darrell Steinberg's staff and also serves as the chief consultant to the Senate Select Committee on Autism & Related Disorders.
